Audio and video recording, and capturing of still images, are prohibited in the Alzheimer's Association (Latinos & Alzheimer's Symposium) poster area and all session rooms, including all sessions held online, by video conference and/or all other remote meeting technologies.

Please respect speaker instructions regarding the taking of photos, video or audio during their presentation.

Because of the proprietary nature of data and the reporting of preliminary, unpublished research findings, the dissemination or reproduction of someone else's slides, poster(s), audio, video or data before, during or after Latinos & Alzheimer's Symposium is strictly prohibited.

Sharing your experience on social media is encouraged to add to the discussion and excitement of Latinos & Alzheimer's Symposium, as long as it complies with Latinos & Alzheimer's Symposium embargo and confidentiality rules, and this policy. Sharing of images on social media that contain discernable research data is prohibited.

Violation of the above restrictions may result in appropriate penalty, including removal from the 3rd Latinos & Alzheimer's Symposium, and denial of entry to future meetings and other conferences hosted by the Alzheimer's Association.
