COMPREHENSIVE ROTATIONS

Core Block Rotations are completed in blocks of four to six weeks. They include ambulatory care, management, Medicare, medication therapy management, pharmacy benefits, prior authorization and trade relations.

Core Longitudinal Rotations run throughout the year and include ambulatory care, clinical programs, drug information, medication therapy management, pharmacy operations and the Western States Project.

 - > Three letters of recommendation, preferably from a pharmacy school professor, work or internship advisor, and an Advanced Pharmacy Practice Experience (APPE) preceptor
 - > Official transcript sent directly from your school of pharmacy

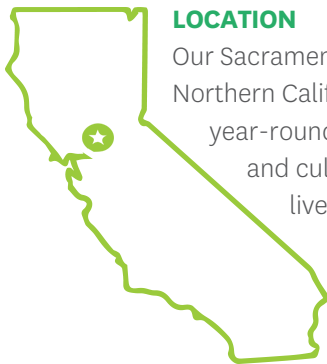


ELIGIBILITY
