 - ACLS by start of clinical rotations

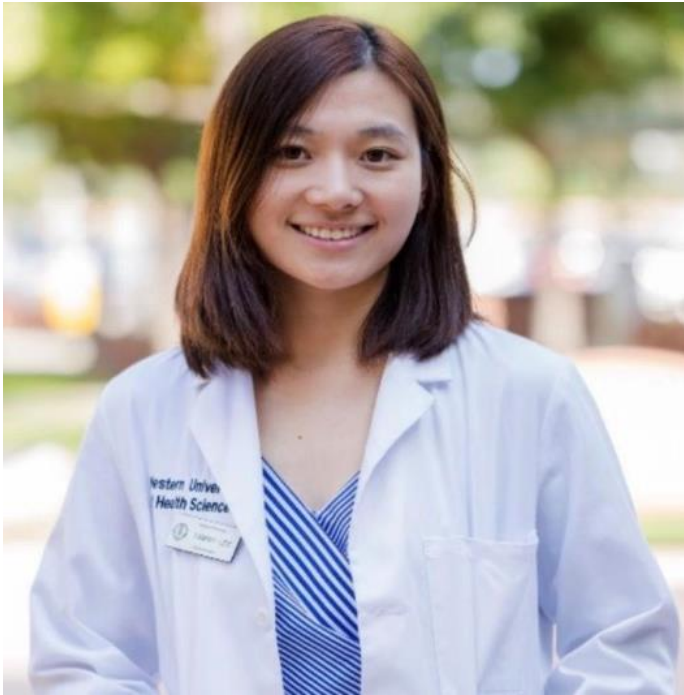
