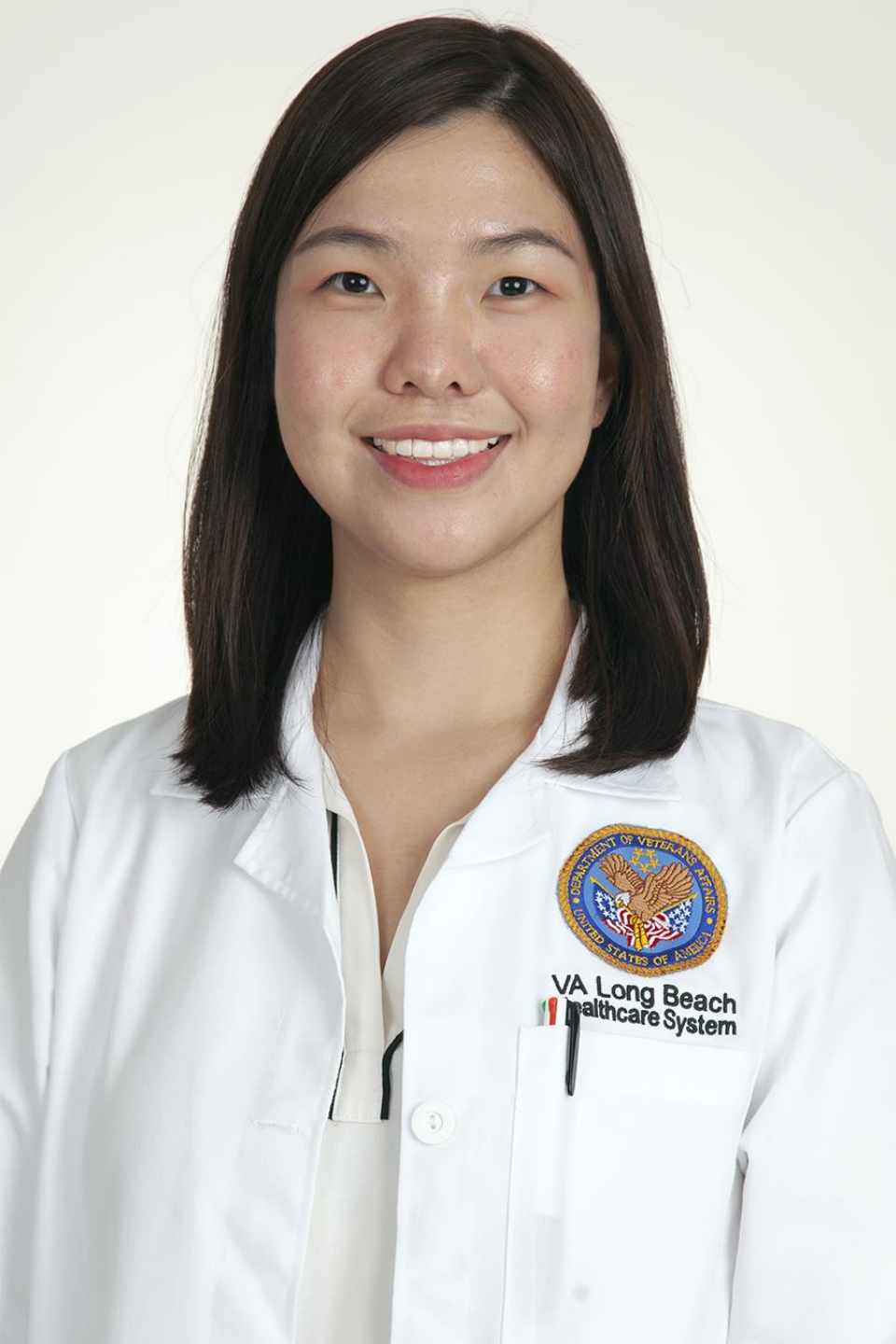
# Residency Showcase Availability

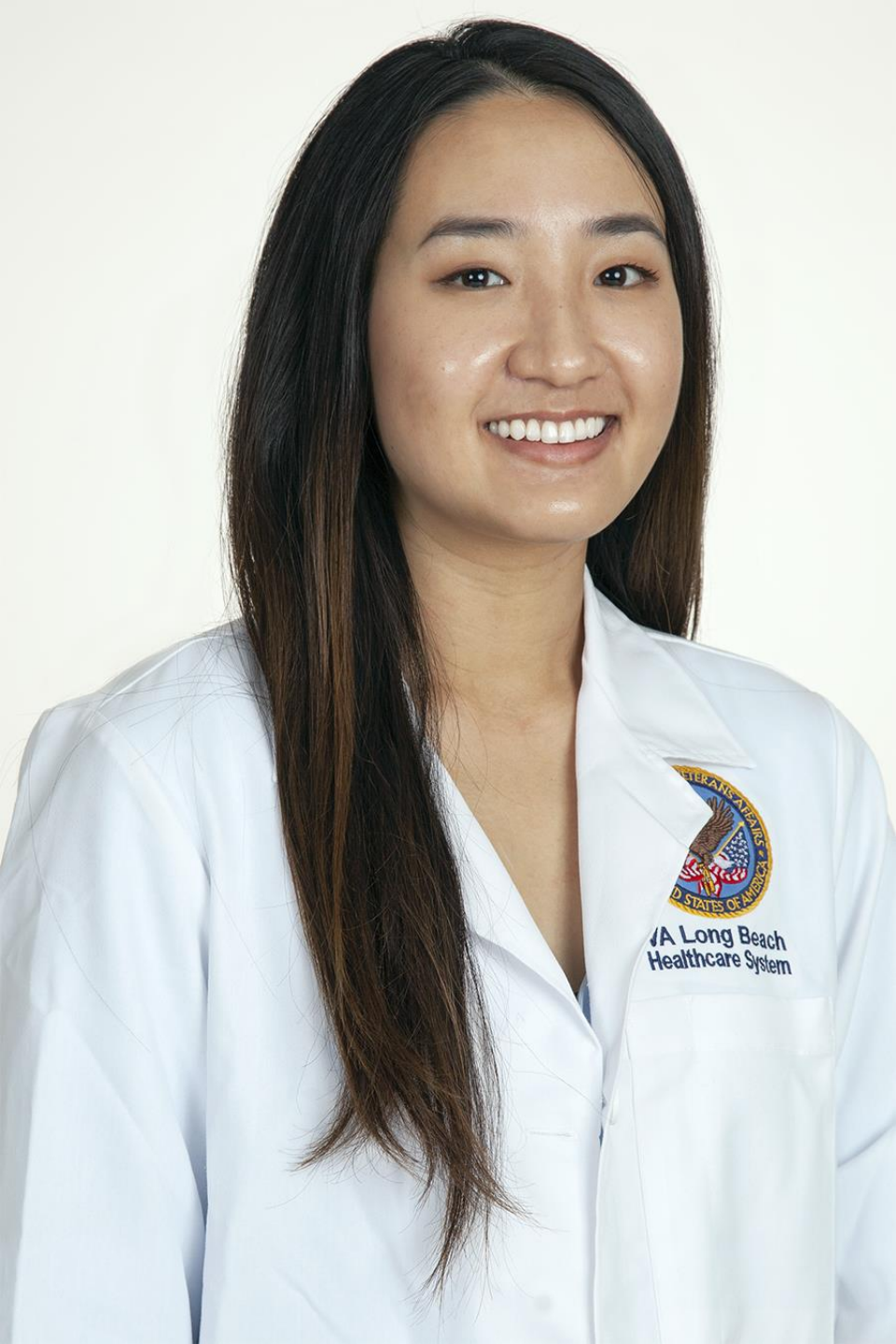
