### Program Overview

The Post Graduate Year (PGY1) Pharmacy Residency program at the California Northstate University College of Pharmacy (CNUCOP) and Adventist Health Lodi Memorial offers a twelve-month rich comprehensive learning and practice experience in advanced clinical practice and academia. At CNUCOP, the pharmacy resident will have unique opportunities to learn development of teaching materials, give didactic lectures, facilitate team-based learning (TBL) classroom discussions, and earn a teaching and learning certificate. The pharmacy resident will assume the clinical pharmacist role at Adventist Health Lodi Memorial and provide optimal patient care in a variety of patient care settings under the guidance of skilled preceptors. The purpose of the PGY1 program is to train the pharmacy resident as a skilled clinical practitioner, researcher, and educator through a collaborative environment.

### California Northstate University College of Pharmacy

CNUCOP is a four-year pharmacy college dedicated to utilizing TBL to educate, develop, and train individuals to provide competent, patient-centered care. The vision of CNUCOP is to innovate active learning strategies in educating students and practitioners and advance the practice of pharmacy.
