- Supports adherence to the serialization law, providing product visibility at a granular, unit of use level.
- Provides access to DoseID™ Master Data Repository for cGMP-relevant data to enable many downstream workflows and help manage recalls, returns, expiry, refrigeration and more.
- Assures Sandoz's tags perform optimally in customer and partner applications.
- Eliminates or reduces tedious and costly manual labelling and RFID tag expense.

Sandoz RFID pre-tagged product launches will be phased between Q4 2020 to Q1 2021.
