Shortly after you order a vascular access service, a Trident representative will call to provide you with our Nurse's ETA.

After the procedure is complete, the following will occur:

- If a PICC is placed, **EKG tip location technology is used for tip placement verification.** If contraindicated (such as patient has Atrial Fibrillation or a pacemaker) an x-ray would be needed.
- The Vascular Access Nurse will give the Facility Nurse a report and have them sign a progress note.
- The Vascular Access Nurse will file the Insertion Record and Consent in the patient's chart.
