

NDHIN Menu of Services

Health Information Exchange (HIE) Clinical Portal that provides access to the patient community health record via a URL/website and is available at the point of care. The health record includes: allergies, medications, immunizations, labs, radiology and other transcribed documents.

Seamless access to NDHIN through EHR integration/Single Sign-On (SSO).

Access to the ND Prescription Drug Monitoring Program through the NDHIN Clinical Portal.

Access to Immunizations from the ND Immunizations Information System (NDIIS).

Access to PACs images from participating providers.

NDHIN's connection to the eHealth Exchange provides opportunity to exchange with other HIEs across state borders.

Direct Secure Messaging provides a secure point-to-point communication tool for safe sharing of protected health information.

Encounter Notifications & Alerts based on data submitted to NDHIN for significant patient events such as ED visits, hospital admits/discharges and abnormal lab results.

Utilization Reports – Ability to run reports to for organizational utilization

Services that assist with Promoting Interoperability Objectives:

I. *Electronic Public Health*

Reporting/Measures

- A. Bidirectional connectivity to the ND Immunization Registry (NDIIS).
- B. Monitor Syndromic Surveillance from ADT (Admission, Discharge, Transfer) feed and route to the ND Department of Health.
- C. Route lab data for Reportable Diseases and route to the ND Department of Health.
- D. Route data to the ND Autism Registry.
- E. Provider PDMP Query.

In Progress:

- A. eHealth Exchange connection to the Veterans Administration, DoD, Social Security Administration.
- B. Single sign on access to the Statewide Health Care Directive Registry to search/query patient advance directives.
- C. Patient Centered Data Home connection.

Future Services:

- A. NDHIN Designation as a Qualified Clinical Data Registry for Quality Reporting.
- B. Population Health Module.
- C. Care Management Tools.
- D. Direct Secure Messaging integration in the NDHIN Clinical Portal.
- E. Modernization of Cancer Registry for interoperability.

NOTE: Interoperability Assistance Program Grant Funds available.

NDHIN provides a gateway for providers to meet the public health reporting measures for Promoting Interoperability Objectives as well as some requirements under Medicare (MACRA/MIPs).
