## FAST FACTS

PCOM Georgia offers the Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine degree, the Doctor of Pharmacy degree, the Doctor of Physical Therapy degree and graduate degree programs in Biomedical Sciences and Physician Assistant Studies.

The 23-acre campus in Suwanee, Georgia, includes the 172,000-square-foot Old Peachtree building and the 21,000-square-foot Northlake building. The campus features large and small classrooms, conference areas and study spaces. Research and multi-use basic science laboratories, an anatomy laboratory, a Simulation Center, three pharmacy practice labs and a large osteopathic manipulative medicine practice suite are housed on campus.

The campus is also home to the Georgia Osteopathic Care Center, an osteopathic manipulative medicine clinic, which is open to the public by appointment.

## FOCUS

PCOM Georgia enrolled its first class in 2005 in response to the acute need for more healthcare providers to serve the growing population of Georgia and the surrounding states. The College encourages graduates to serve where the need is greatest—inner cities and rural areas with severe physician shortages.
