The Midwestern University Master of Arts in Biomedical Science (M.A.) degree program is designed to help students with a bachelor's degree improve their academic foundation in the biomedical sciences and augment their credentials for admission into a health professional program.

- The M.A. in Biomedical Science degree program is a full-time, three-quarter graduate program.
- All students take classes in the basic sciences and medical ethics and complete a capstone course. The capstone course includes preparation of a scholarly, literature-based portfolio on a topic of the student's choice and a presentation of this topic in a seminar format. In addition, students are required to take 15 or more elective credits to improve critical thinking skills and study skills, and enhance their preparation for professional school application.
- A premium is placed on interdisciplinary education and integrating all aspects of the health care continuum. Therefore, students from all disciplines of health care study together with health care administrators and other interested individuals.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS:

1. A cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale
2. Completion of a bachelor's degree, from a regionally accredited college or university prior to matriculation, preferably with a major in the sciences
3. Test scores from one of the following: Graduate Record Examination (GRE), Medical College Admissions Tests (MCAT), Pharmacy College Admissions Test (PCAT), Dental Admissions Test (DAT), Optometry Admissions Test (OAT), or other professional program admissions test no more than three years prior to planned enrollment year
4. Two letters of recommendation (or one committee letter from the applicant's college or university)
